Friends in Christ,

As Pope Francis continues taking the world by storm, winning the hearts of people everywhere, the trek toward Easter continues. This Sunday, Palm Sunday, is the beginning of Holy Week. Wednesday and Thursday the church will be open for prayer and adoration from 9 AM-12 noon.



Thursday night we will celebrate the Mass of the Lord's Supper beginning at 7. The Mass will be followed by the traditional Holy Thursday procession to the altar of repose, where adoration will be observed till 11.

Good Friday's Veneration of the Cross observance begins at 7, Friday night. While Mass will not be celebrated, Holy Communion will be offered to the faithful.

Don't forget that for those who are not exempt, Good Friday is a day of strict fasting and abstinence. No meat, and only one full meal that day.

There will be no confessions heard on Holy Saturday, nor will the Saturday evening Mass be celebrated. We are still a mission. Easter Vigil Masses will be celebrated only after we become an independent parish.

Finally, Easter Sunday Masses will be celebrated at 8 AM and 10 AM. Our traditional Easter egg hunt will follow the 10 AM Mass, and, kids, do not forget to bring your Easter baskets. I will bless them at the end of each Mass.

A Prayer for Pope Francis I

Dear Lord,

We rejoice in the election of our new Holy Father, Pope Francis I. What a wonderful gift you have bestowed upon us in this courageous leader!

We thank you for your continued guidance of our Most Holy Church, and we pray you continue to extend your blessings to our Church Fathers and all your faithful.

We ask that you be with Francis now, as he embarks on a great undertaking, shepherding, stewarding, and renewing the flock.

We pledge to you, our Lord, our most true and humble obedience to your will through our Holy Father who guides and fosters us through these turbulent times.

Amen.

On Palm Sunday, we celebrate the first joy of the season, as we celebrate Our Lord's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem where he was welcomed by crowds worshiping him and laying down palm leaves before him. It also marks the beginning of Holy Week, with the greatest tragedy and sorrow of the year.

Jesus' triumphant return to Jerusalem is only one side of the story.

By now many of the Jews are filled with hate for Our Lord. They want to see him stoned, calling Him a blasphemer, especially after offering proof of His Divinity during a winter visit to Jerusalem for the Feast of the Dedication.

After this, Jesus went to Perea, where he was summoned to Bethany. There he raised Lazarus from the dead, a miracle which wins Him such renown among certain Pharisees that they decided finally to end His life.

Jesus took refuge at Ephrem returning six days before Passover to Bethany, triumphantly entering Jerusalem. That evening, He leaves Jerusalem and returns Monday. He spent time with Gentiles in the Temple, and on Wednesday left for the Mount of Olives. Here he foretold the apostles the events of the next several days, including His impending death.

He returned to Jerusalem on Thursday, to share the Last Supper with His apostles. He was subsequently arrested and tried. He was crucified at Calvary on Friday, outside the gates of Jerusalem.

He was buried the same day, and arose three days later, on Easter Sunday.

All of this is done by our Lord for forgiveness of our sins, and for life everlasting with Him.

God so loved us, that He sent His only begotten Son to die for us, so that our sins maybe forgiven.

From February 13 through March 24, you're invited to join other Christians for **40 Days for Life** – 40 days of prayer and fasting for an end to abortion. You're also invited to stand and peacefully pray during a 40-day vigil in the public right-of way outside Planned Parenthood located at 4300 Ridgecrest Dr. Suite P, and also to help spread the word about this important community outreach.
