Sacristy

Definition abbreviated from Catholic Encyclopedia: A room in the church or attached thereto, where the vestments, church furnishings and the like, sacred vessels, and other treasures are kept, and where the clergy meet and vest for the various ecclesiastical functions. The sacristy is not blessed or consecrated together with the church, and consequently is not a sacred place in the canonical sense. However, except where penalties are concerned, it enjoys on the whole the same prerogatives as the church.

Now that you know the official definition we wish to ask that you recognize the **Sacristy** as part of the church. As such no food or drink is allowed in the **Sacristy**. In the same regard that you would not consider walking through the main church to get to the other hall you should not be walking through the **Sacristy** to get to the teacher lounge or vise-versa. Only the Priest and volunteers serving the mass should be in the **Sacristy**. Ours is a small **Sacristy** and get crowded quite fast. If you need to speak to the priest please knock on the door and wait to be recognized.

We thank you for your attention to this special part of the church and the need of the Priest and volunteers use of the **Sacristy** in preparing for mass along with the proper clean up after mass of the Church Sacred Vessels.
