Liturgical Colors

For those that notice, the priest will be changing colors later this month. Not literally but his Vestments. So as a reminder of what color for what season here goes a crash course.

Green: Used on Sundays and weekdays when no special feasts or seasons are celebrated. It symbolizes Christian hope.

Purple: Worn during Advent and Lent. Symbolizes penance and personal need for conversion.

Red: Used on Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Pentecost, and other Masses of the Holy Spirit and feasts of martyrs. Symbolizes the majesty of Christ in his Passion and the heroic shedding of martyrs' blood.

White: For the seasons of Christmas, Easter, solemnities of Christ, feast of the Blessed Mother, virgins, and confessors. White symbolizes Resurrection, purity, birth, rebirth, and holiness. (In some cases gold is used in place of white.) Also used at wedding and funerals.
