It is the time of year to wonder: Where are our parishioners? I know, people are on vacation, traveling. I would like to see the migration path of Roman Catholics during the summer months. I want to go to those churches with standing-room-only due to the many travelers visiting them. Does no one travel to Sunny New Mexico?
