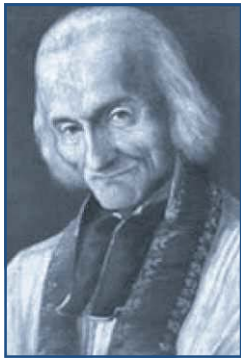

Baked Macaroni and Cheese III

Prep Time: 15 Min | Cook Time: 30 Min | Ready In: 45 Min

Ingredients

- 1 (16 ounce) package elbow macaroni
- 1/2 cup evaporated milk
- 2 eggs
- 1 (8 ounce) container sour cream
- 1 teaspoon seasoning salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 1/2 cups shredded Cheddar cheese
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 tablespoon butter

Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Add pasta and cook for 8 to 10 minutes or until al dente; drain and rinse with cold water. In a bowl mix milk, eggs, sour cream, seasoning salt, and pepper. Layer macaroni, cheddar cheese, and milk mixture until pan is full. Sprinkle Parmesan cheese and pour melted butter on top. Bake in a preheated oven for 20 to 30 minutes or until milk mixture is done. Feeds ~10 Hungry Parishioners or Carl.

Boston Baked Beans

Prep Time: 30 Min | Cook Time: 4 Hrs | Ready In: 5 Hrs

Ingredients

- 2 cups navy beans
- 1/2 pound bacon
- 1 onion, finely diced
- 3 tablespoons molasses
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon dry mustard
- 1/2 cup ketchup
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1/4 cup brown sugar

Directions

Soak beans overnight in cold water. Simmer the beans in the same water until tender, approximately 1 to 2 hours. Drain and reserve the liquid. Preheat oven to 325 degrees F. Arrange the beans in a 2 quart bean pot or casserole dish by placing a portion of the beans in the bottom of dish, and layering them with bacon and onion. In a saucepan, combine molasses, salt, pepper, dry mustard, ketchup, Worcestershire sauce and brown sugar. Bring the mixture to a boil and pour over beans. Pour in just enough of the reserved bean water to cover the beans. Cover the dish with a lid or aluminum foil. Bake for 3 to 4 hours in the preheated oven, until beans are tender. Remove the lid about halfway through cooking, and add more liquid if necessary to prevent the beans from getting too dry.

2nd President of the United States

Nickname: Father of American Independent

Born: October 30, 1735; Massachusetts

Political Party: Federalist

Term of Office: 1797-1801

Vice President: Thomas Jefferson

Historical Facts:

- John Adams grew up enjoying books, kites, toy boats, and marbles. As an adult, he practice law in Boston.
- After becoming a delegate to the First and Second Continental Congresses, Adams often encouraged colonists to seek independence from Great Britain.
- Eventually, Adams helped craft the Declaration of Independence and served as Vice President under George Washington.

Flash Fact:

- Adams died on the 50th anniversary of the approval of the Declaration of Independence (July 4) - the same exact day as Thomas Jefferson, the only other signer of the Declaration to become President.
